

## Disclosure Statement

Your immunotherapy can be administered by the following methods: orally (allergy drops) or by injection (allergy shots).

### Allergy Shots: Subcutaneous Immunotherapy

Allergy shots are generally covered in whole or part by your insurance provider. This is a billable service and you will be responsible for any part of this service not covered by your insurance provider. Billable services for allergy shots include serum mixing, shot administration, and vial testing.

### Allergy Drops: Sublingual Immunotherapy

This service is usually not covered by most major insurances and is not FDA approved. Payment for allergy drops must be collected in advance even if this is a covered benefit. The cost for allergy drops is currently either \$80.00 or \$160.00 for the starter set and \$95.00 or \$190 for the maintenance sets. The final cost is determined by how many allergens are identified during your allergy test. This fee is paid by you and is not billed to your insurance provider unless this is a covered benefit with your insurance company. We will file with your insurance only if allergy drops are a covered benefit. Cost included in this service includes serum mixing, supplies, and instructions for administration. **All fees associated with allergy drops are non-refundable.**
